



This year's conference theme is "Lewis and Clark, The Corps of Discovery" and will specifically contrast contemporary environmental issues in the Pacific Northwest with issues cited by Lewis and Clark in their journals or by historians. Session topics are expected to include air quality, environmental management and sustainability, integration of environmental preservation and economic development, with speakers from the policy, permit, and project management arenas, and a keynote address by Stephenie Ambrose Tubbs entitled, "The Role of Lewis and Clark in Opening the West".

Three hundred or more delegates, speakers, and exhibitors are expected from throughout the United States and Canada. The conference receives strong agency support, with many regional air quality and environmental agency staff in attendance, as well as industry representatives, consultants, and environmental planners, managers, and attorneys. In addition, PNWIS and A&WMA enjoy the membership of strong student chapters, and many students attend.

The annual PNWIS conference has been widely recognized as a high-quality technical conference that is a catalyst for environmental leadership providing a neutral forum for discussion, education, and networking on technical issues relating to environmental management.
